the superintendent of the Harrison County Board of



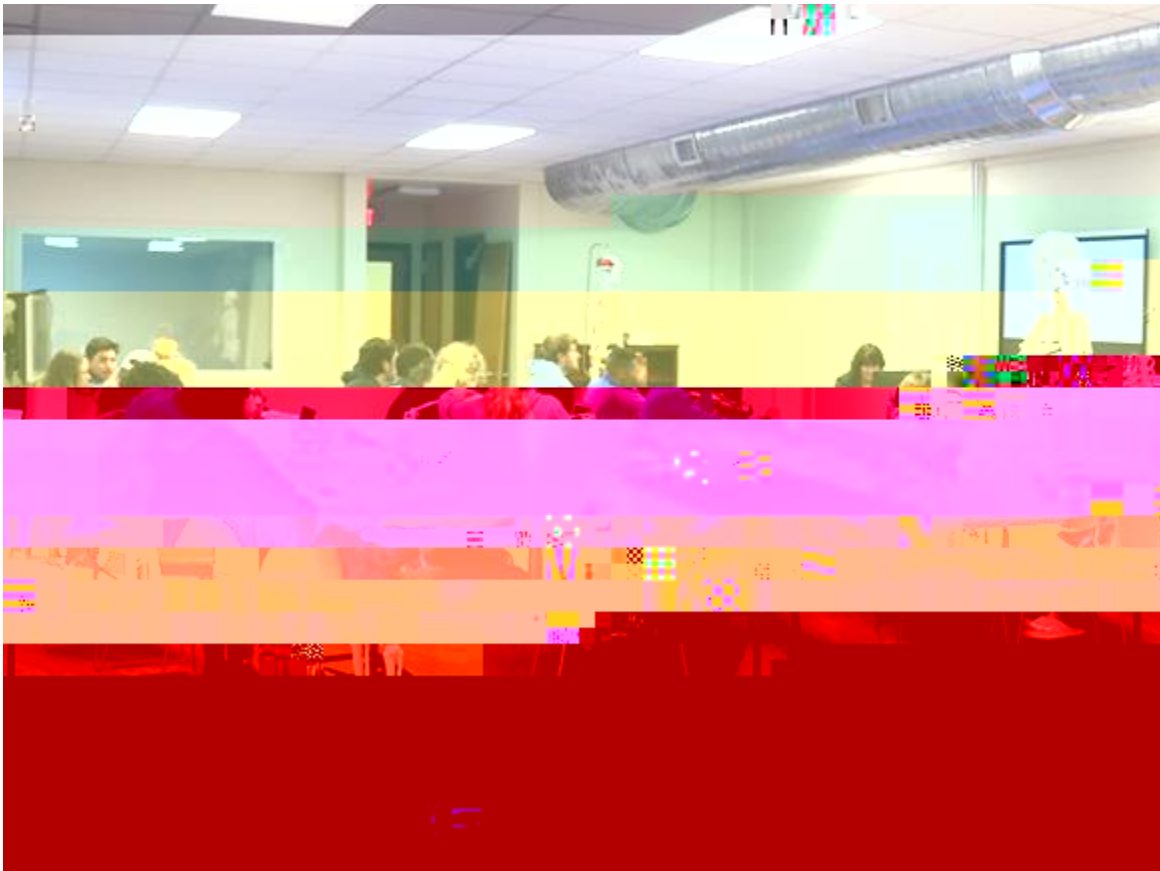


## The Nancy Lemon and Michael Rust Health and Human Performance Lab at Glenville State College
