Education, Supervisor of Student Teachers, and Director of the Child Learning Center.

She took on the additional duties of Director of Field Experiences in 1990 while retaining her other positions and served in those areas until 1994 when she was promoted to Associate Professor. Butler was able to relinquish her Director of Field Experiences position at that time but ably continued all of her other duties until in 1998 when she was tapped to serve as Interim Dean of Teacher Education and Cef Certification Officer, these in addition to continuing in her Associate Professor of Education and Director of the Child Learning Cer positions.

Dr. Butler was promoted to full Professor in 1999 and named Dean of Teacher Education while maintaining her Professor of Education and Director of the Child Learning Duties. She went on to serve GSC as Associate Vice President for Academic Affairs, Professor of Education, and NC/Higher Learning Commission Accreditation Coordinator from 2000-2003 and was promoted yet again to Interim Vice President for Academic Affairs in 2003 and then was Provost and Senior Vice President for Academic Affairs from 2004-2010.

She left GSC in 2010 to serve as Vice Chancellor for
