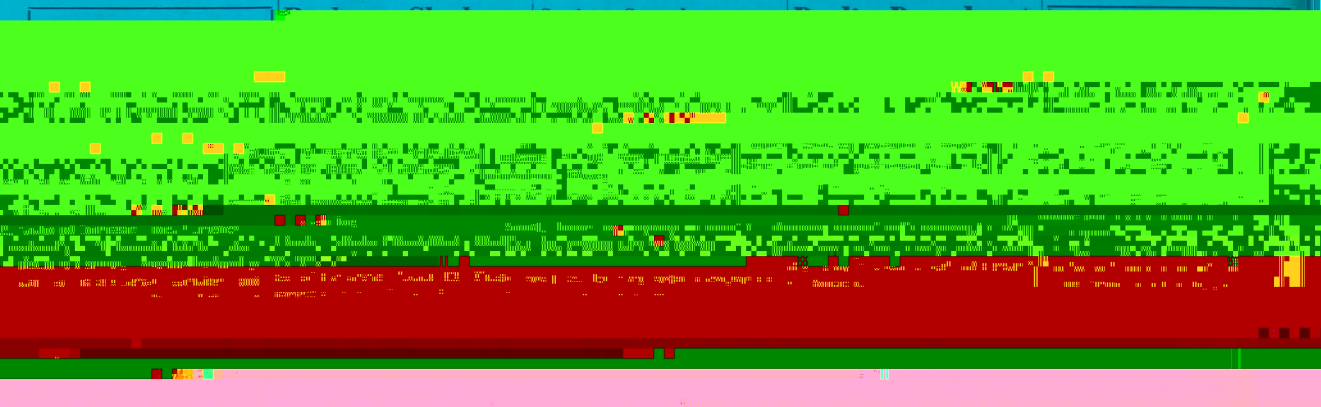


Left: Dionears' (dark) and Gillisnie's (light) teams in action during the game. Right: Gillisnie's team celebrating their victory.

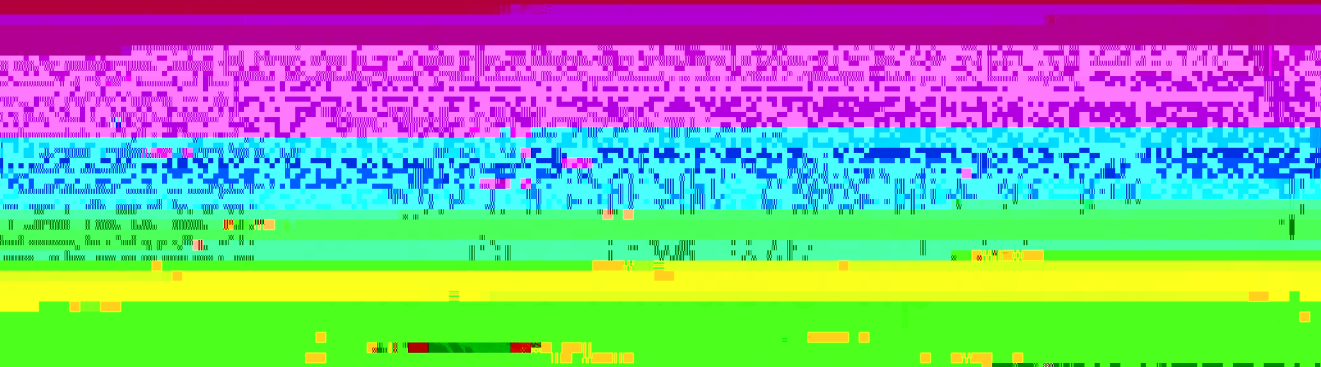

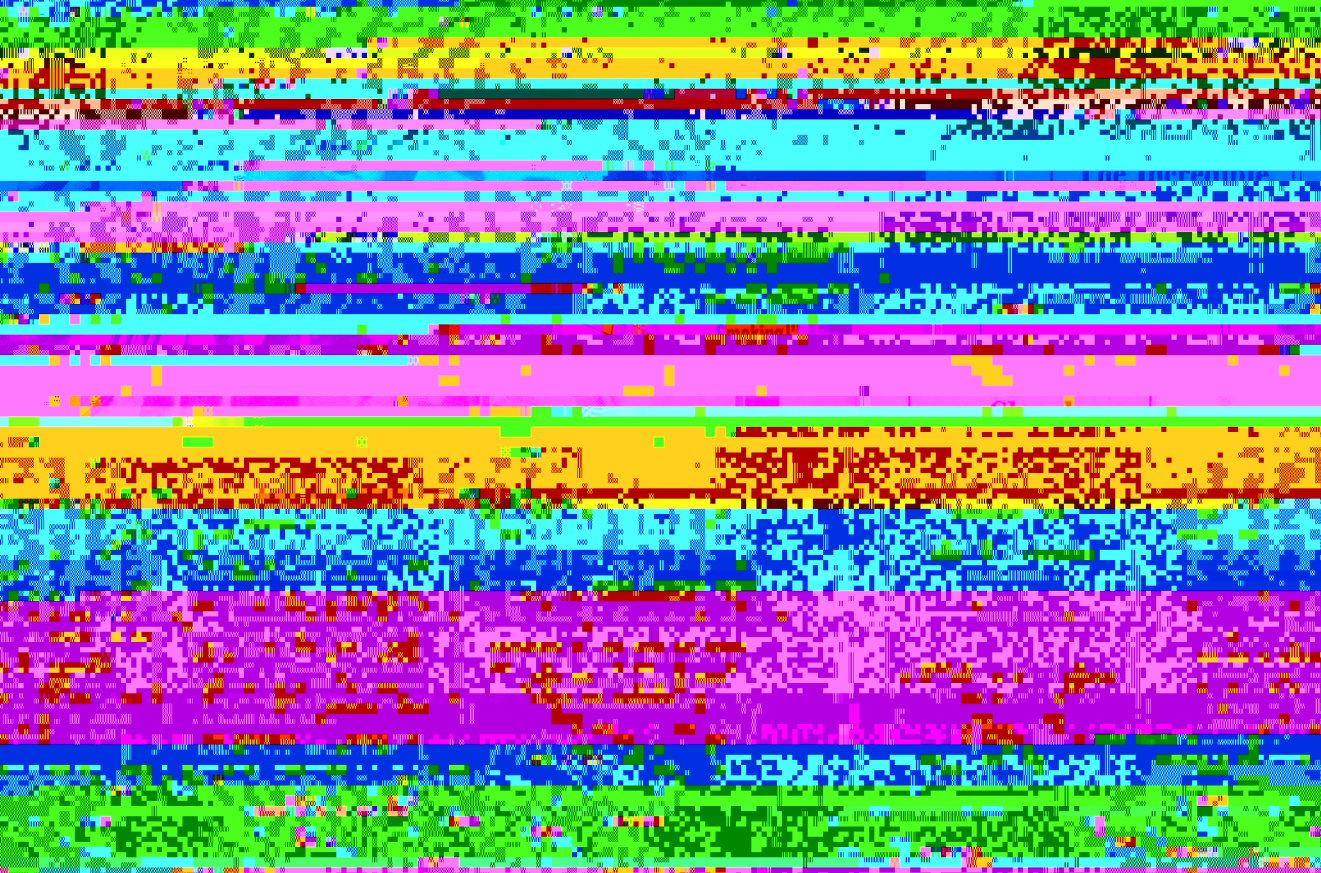
